It is agreed, in order to adhere with the current social distancing guidelines for events at The Ritz-Carlton, South Beach, all attendees to the event must be previously informed to comply with the below guidelines as stated Miami Dade County and Miami Beach ordinances.

Capacity Limitations

Physical distancing is critical to help slow the spread of COVID-19.

Social distancing protocols must be observed by guests and staff, as outlined below:

Physical Distancing

- Guests must maintain social distancing between other guests and wear masks or cloth face that covers the nose and the mouth at any time.
- Guests must not gather in any area in groups larger than 10 and must follow CDC's social distancing guidelines.
- Guests must practice social distancing measures coupled with the use of hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette. This includes:
 - No hugging, kissing, fist-bumps, or shaking hands with guests as well as among staff.
 - Maintaining a distance of at least 6 feet.
 - Avoiding anyone who is coughing or sneezing.
- Staff will be reminded not to touch their faces and to practice physical distancing by standing at least six feet away from guests and other staff whenever possible.

Hand Sanitizer

- Hand sanitizer dispensers will be placed at the entrance of the function and is placed in public areas throughout the resort, unless bathrooms with water and soap are available close by for their use.

Event Guidelines

- Banquets tables must be arranged to ensure appropriate distancing – maximum of 8 guests per table.
- Tables must be organized such that the distance from the back of one chair to the back of another chair shall be at least 6 feet apart and guests shall face each other from a distance of at least 3 feet.
- Theatre seating can be set up to 6 chairs side-by-side with 6 feet between the next set of chairs.
- Banquet set-up arrangements will allow for physical distancing between guests based on CDC and state recommendations.
- All food and beverage items will be individually plated and served.
- Any station or buffet requires a Plexiglas shield and chef attendant to serve the guest.
- A station or buffet should follow a phased approach with 3-6 feet placed between each station or buffet.
- Event attendees shall wear a mask while on the premises, including when going to/from the restrooms or moving to other areas of the room.
- A guest may remove their mask when seated and actively eating or drinking.
- A standing guest may remove their mask to take a drink, but then replace the mask until the next drink is taken.
- No single event shall run for longer than 6 consecutive hours.
